

WIENER MUSEUM OF DECORATIVE ARTS

Dania Beach, FL. – The Wiener Museum of Decorative Arts (WMODA) is a world-class museum in South Florida celebrating the fired arts of ceramics and glass. The museum features thousands of works from the world’s most renowned ceramic and glass artists. In addition to a vast collection of 19th and 20th century British pottery and porcelain from factories, such as Wedgwood and Royal Doulton, the Wiener Museum displays works by contemporary ceramic artists from the UK and South Africa.

A spectacular collection of Dale Chihuly’s work is exhibited in the *Hot Glass* gallery at WMODA along with works by other great glass artists in our *Art on Fire* exhibit, including William Morris and Toots Zynsky. Recent glass installations include *Constellations*, a dazzling display of Windstars by Rob Stern. WMODA also hosts an exciting program of exhibitions, including *Fantastique* which explores the enchanted world of ceramic art, *Carnival & Cabaret* which celebrates the art of having fun, the *Art of Tea*, which presents the ritual of afternoon tea, and *Safari*, exploring Ardmore ceramic art from the savanna to the sea.

WMODA is located inside the Gallery of Amazing Things at 481 South Federal Highway in Dania Beach, just south of Fort Lauderdale – Hollywood International Airport. WMODA is open to the public Tuesday through Saturday from 10 am. to 4 pm.
